NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 The CSA Classic Rating Rule will apply for all yachts except for Spirit of Tradition where the CSA Rating Rule will apply.

1.3 Antigua Classic Yacht Regatta (ACYR) Minimum Safety Rules apply

1.4 Under World Sailing Test Rule DR21-01 change the definition of *Start* as follows:

Start A boat starts when her hull having been entirely on the pre-start side of the starting line, any part of her hull crosses the starting line from the pre-start side to the course side either;

(a) at or after her starting signal, or

(b) during the last minute before her starting signal.

When a yacht *starts* in accordance with item (b) of the definition she shall not return to the pre-start side of the line, and 5 minutes will be added to her elapsed time.

1.5 Any other changes to the RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 Advertising

Yachts may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

2. Eligibility

All yachts must be registered in Antigua Classics Yacht Regatta.

The race is open to all classes except for Modern Classics.

4 Classes

Small Classics Class, 20'-45' LOD

Large Classics Class, over 45' LOD

Spirit of Tradition

5 Schedule

Wednesday 19th April 0800-1800 Registration and Inspection at Nelson's Dockyard.

Thursday 20th April 1200 Single Handed Race Skippers' Briefing
1400 1st start Single Handed Race
1800 SHR Prize Giving, Dark and Stormys.

6 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be issued at Registration and may be posted on the website earlier.

7 Venue

The race will take place off the South coast of Antigua.

8 Courses

11.1 Start and finish will be immediately outside the entrance to Falmouth Harbour.

11.2 The course will be windward/leeward, between English Harbour and Rendezvous Bay.

11.3 Detailed course information will be provided at registration.

9 Safety Requirements

9.1 All yachts shall carry one passenger, for emergency assistance only.

9.2 Extra crew may be carried to assist setting sail but must be off the yacht before the 10 minute warning signal.

9.3 The OA may require or permit one photographer on selected yachts.

10 Scoring

One race is required to complete a series.

11 Prizes

1st, 2nd and 3rd for Large and Small Classics

1st for Spirit of Tradition Class

12 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk per RRS 3, Decision to Race. The OA and ACYR will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.

13 Insurance

Each participating yacht shall be insured with valid third party insurance for the duration of the event.
